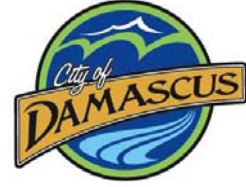


## Recruiting New Members to Serve on CCI



The city is recruiting volunteers who live within the City of Damascus to serve on the Committee for Citizen Involvement (CCI). Applicants should possess a clear understanding of public participation processes that can be demonstrated through education, practical application or both.

The CCI provides a communication conduit between the Damascus City Council and citizens of Damascus on aspects of city business.

Those who serve on this committee will be asked to commit to meeting a minimum of once per month throughout the duration of their appointed term. In the interim CCI members will be asked to promote citizen involvement within their own area of representation and bring citizen feedback and concerns back to the entire CCI.

Initial terms of appointment may be either two or three years. Citizens who are interested in serving may apply by filling out the committee application form. The committee application form is available on the city website at [www.ci.damascus.or.us](http://www.ci.damascus.or.us) and hard copies are available at city hall, located at 19920 SE Highway 212.

Submitting an application does not guarantee a spot on this or any other committee. All committee members must be appointed by the Mayor with the Council's consent in accordance with the City Charter, chapter 3, section 8.
